
# Interesting Bits

In Europe however, Jaguar crossed a VDP with an XJR to produce a supercharged VDP under the name *Daimler Super 8*. Just recently, Jaguar has decided to bring this powerhouse of a sedan to our side of the pond. Now Daimler is not a well recognized name in North America,




so when Jaguar started to bring in the Super 8, it was re-badged as a *Supercharged VDP* – which makes sense – at least in the U.S. it does (more on this to follow). As the accompanying photos show, there is a

I'm sure there are a number of engineering differences, but information on this is scarce. 


