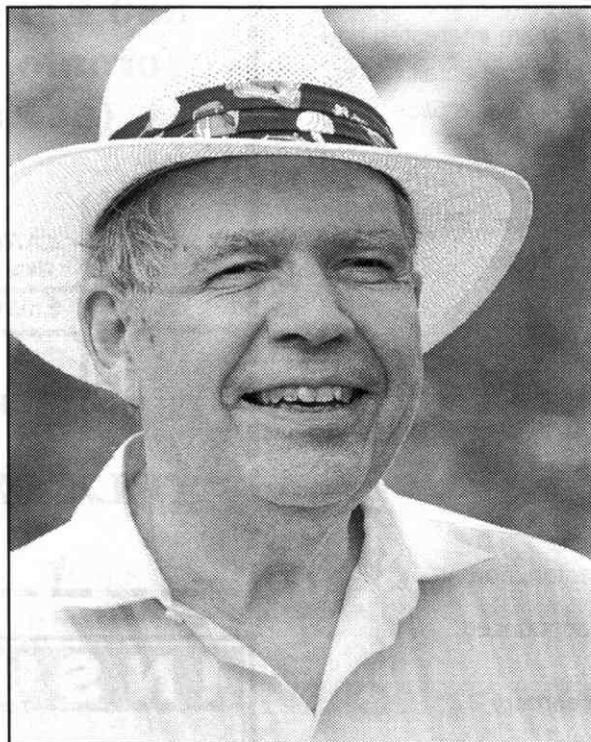


From the President's Pen

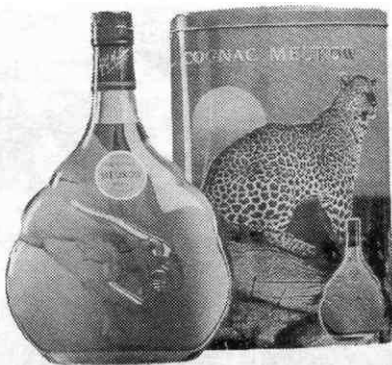

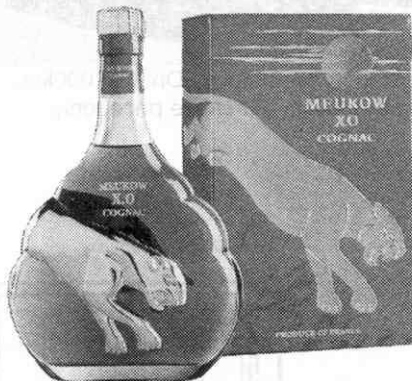

Oct '99 Meeting Review

Legal counsel has been asked to review and advise if any changes necessary as we are incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario. We hope to return a signed agreement before the end of the year.
- Correspondence was received from *The Classic Car Attic* of the Philippines advertising their Web page and offering us to take advantage of same. Our club's involvement with the Web will be the subject of discussion in the future.
- In Dorothee Anne's absence **Peter** advised our membership to be about 180.
- **Linda** and **Murray Smith**, with **John Taglione**, were given a fine hand for the excellent weather, outstanding fall leaf display, delightful tour through Halton's back country, mysterious clues, and the best attended (21 cars) *Fall Regularity Run* this club has ever seen. Murray went on to explain the route changes dictated by road construction activities that popped up like dandelions. There was good food, thirst quenchers, and good company for all.

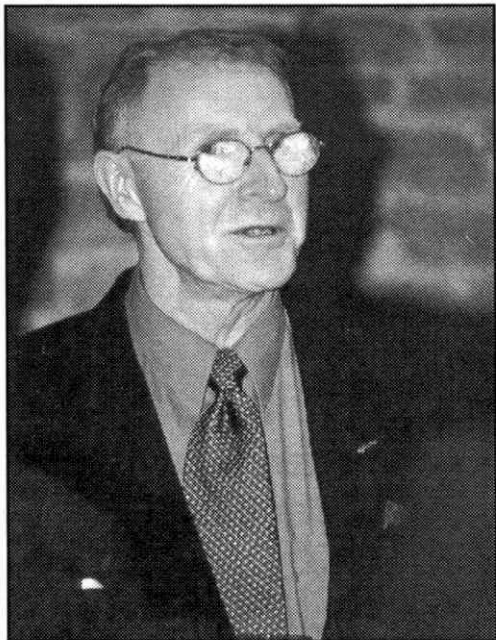

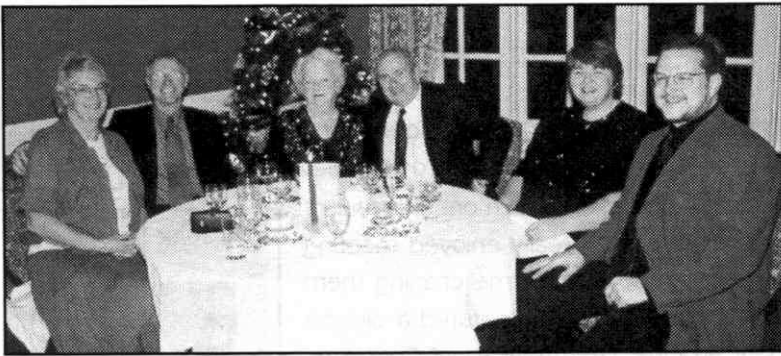

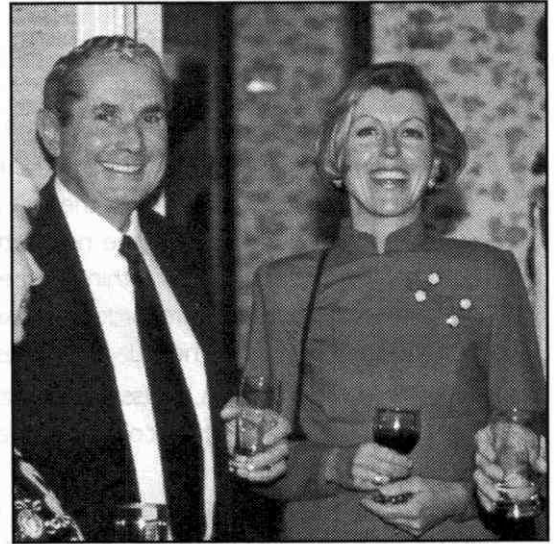

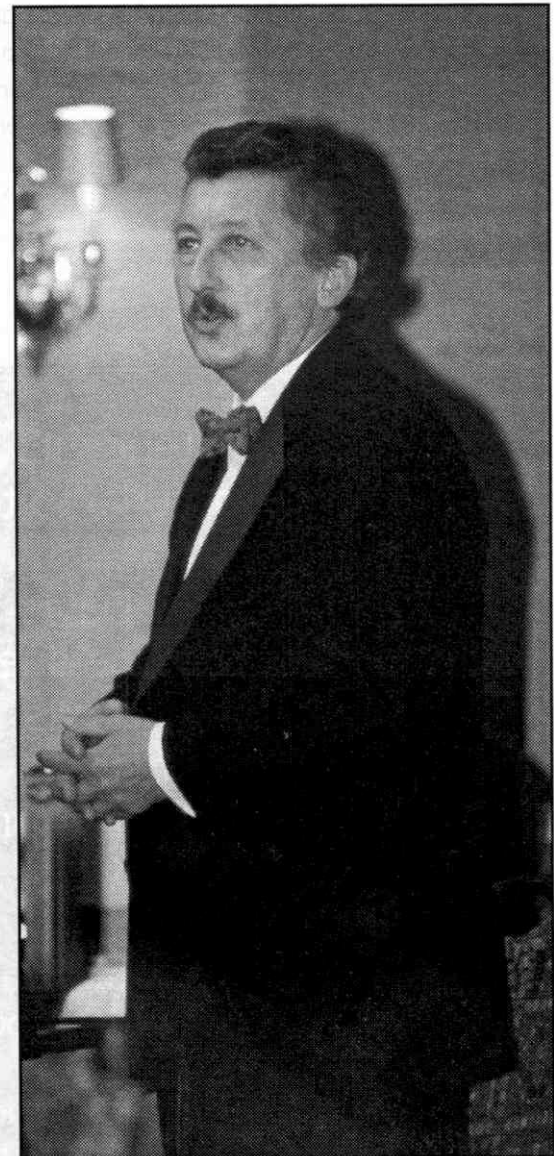

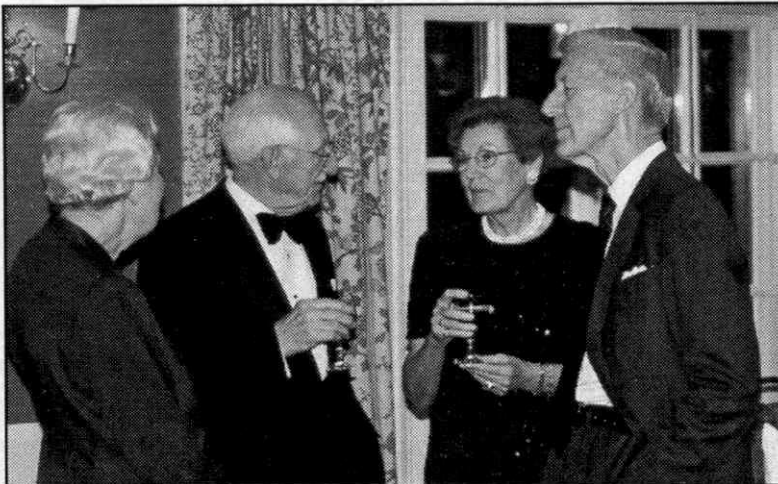
